The Research Summit with the theme "Sustainable Health through Research" was held on 11th December 2010 – At the auditorium Unit Media & Teknologi Pendidikan (UMTP). The summit was officiated by Prof Dr Rosnah Ismail, Deputy Vice Chancellor in Research and Innovation. This one day seminar aimed to share knowledge, summarize research outcomes and exploring new findings of research projects on clinical as well as public health issues conducted by the School of Medicine, UMS.



The objective is to explore the quantity and quality of research projects conducted in the School of Medicine co-researched with external experts or assessor. The organizer will systematically record research projects done in the School of Medicine and organize similar research summit annually. Assoc. Prof. Dr Than Myint, the chairman of the research summit 2010 announced that there were 42 researchers who presented 29 interactive posters and 13 oral presentations.
