

**A new species of *Setosabatieria* Platt, 1985 (Nematoda: Comesomatidae)  
from Chek Jawa, Singapore, with a key to valid species of the genus**

**Abstract**

A new species of Comesomatidae Filipjev, 1918 is described from an intertidal sandy-muddy beach at Chek Jawa, Singapore. *Setosabatieria singaporensis* sp. nov. is characterized by having an amphideal fovea with 2.75-3.0 turns, 14-17 cervical setae per row, 17-20 small preloacal supplements, arcuate spicules with a central cuticularized strip, a leaf-like cuticle extension and gubernacular apophyses bent ventrally in the distal portion.
