Valiguna flava (Heynemann, 1885) from Indonesia and Malaysia: Redescription and comparison with Valiguna siamensis (Martens, 1867) (Gastropoda: Soleolifera: Veronicellidae)

Abstract

We redescribe and figure Valiguna flava, an almost unknown Southeast-Asian land slug. Detailed morphology, radula, jaw and living specimens of Valiguna flava were studied for the first time, based on material recently collected in Borneo and on the holotype. VI. flava is also compared with Valiguna siamensis, the only other species of the genus, which is for the first time recorded in China
