

Schefflera beamanii

ABSTRACT

Schefflera beamanii is restricted to Bukit Hampuan Forest Reserve, Sabah which is a Totally Protected Area (TPA). The estimated area of occupancy (AOO) and extent of occurrence (EOO) are both 8 km² and not declining. Due to fire events within the reserve in the past, forest fire is a serious plausible threat to the species in the future. This event could drive the species towards Critically Endangered or Extinct in the near future. Hence, it is assessed as Vulnerable. *Schefflera beamanii* is endemic to Sabah, Malaysia. It is restricted to the Bukit Hampuan Forest Reserve.
