ABSTRACT

Ixora fulgida is a small tree, endemic to Sabah. The estimated area of occupancy (AOO) and extent of occurrence (EOO) are 120 km² and 54,978 km², respectively. It is widespread across the state and occurs in at least 11 protected areas in Sabah with no major threat to its population. It is assessed as Least Concern. *Ixora fulgida* is endemic to Sabah, Malaysia. It is widespread across the state.
