

Symplocos deflexa

ABSTRACT

Symplocos deflexa is a small tree, endemic to Sabah. The estimated area of occupancy (AOO) and extent of occurrence (EOO) are 28 km² and 34.5 km², respectively. Majority of the records of this species are from Kinabalu Park, a protected area. There is no immediate threat to this species. Hence, it is assessed as Least Concern. *Symplocos deflexa* is endemic to Sabah, Malaysia. It is known from Tenompok, Mount Kinabalu and the local vicinity, Ranau.
