ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study are to describe the elements that influence local culture and local culture that supports community development at Banceuy, Sanca Village, Ciater District, Subang Regency, West Java Province. This study uses a qualitative descriptive research method with a case study approach. Primary data collection techniques include interviews, observation, document study and focus group discussions.
